A great example of our commitment to supporting families beyond treatment is the Healing Through Nature program. Launched with the generous support of the Conrad Prebys Foundation, this initiative helps cancer survivors, their siblings, and parents heal from the trauma of medical treatment by reducing isolation, rebuilding connections, and harnessing the restorative power of nature. It's a powerful way for families to find peace and reconnect in a healing environment.

Looking ahead to 2025, we will deepen our presence in San Diego, expand into Orange County, and continue to grow our Ride with Emilio program. Our team will also conduct a needs assessment to better understand and address the unique challenges each community faces to strengthen the Orange County Family Resource Center.

Through our continuum of care, we provide essential support, including no-cost medical transportation, hospital-approved snacks, financial assistance, and post-treatment emotional healing. We also offer one-on-one support, guiding each family through their unique journey with personalized care.

Our mission is simple: To provide families with unwavering support and compassion as they navigate their child's battle with cancer and other life-threatening diseases, helping them find strength along the way.

Why ENF Is Essential, Now More Than Ever

Childhood Cancer and Life-Threatening Diseases by the Numbers

Childhood cancer doesn't discriminate—it can shatter any family's world in an instant. No parent should have to choose between paying bills and getting their child to treatment, or face the unimaginable loss of a child alone. At ENF, we stand beside families every step of the way, breaking down barriers so they can focus on what matters most—fighting for their child's life. Here's why our work is so vital:


- **iil in 285 children** in the U.S. will be diagnosed with cancer before the age of 20 (American Cancer Society, 2024).
- ⇔Over **50% of families** face transportation barriers to medical appointments, which can result in delayed or missed treatments, putting children's lives at risk (National Cancer Institute, 2023).
- **Medical bankruptcy** is a leading cause of financial distress for families of children with cancer, with families often having to choose between paying for life-saving treatments and meeting basic needs (Journal of Clinical Oncology, 2021).
- **Survival rates** for children with cancer are significantly higher when treatments are consistent and timely, yet many families struggle with access (National Cancer Institute, 2024).

OUR PROGRAMS

The Continuum of Care: ENF's Six Programs

Our ENF team walks alongside families at every stage of their child's illness—offering life-saving support. Our six programs provide a safety net of care, ensuring that no family fights alone.

Family Resource Center

Our team offers multilingual, wrap-around services, connecting families to shelter, food, mental health support, employment, childcare, and more. We also offer bedside assistance when a child is in the hospital.

2024 Impact:

- 168 families served (50% increase from 2023)
- 550 holiday gifts distributed
- 705 lunches & 440 Thanksgiving meals provided
- 65 backpacks given to children in need

The need for support surged threefold in 2024, leading to the hiring of a Family Resource Center Manager and the implementation of an improved intake system to capture family needs in more detail and ensure tailored assistance.



Ride With Emilio

Reliable, no-cost transportation so children never miss critical treatment due to financial or logistical barriers.

2024 Impact:

- 101,664 miles driven
- 2,583 families supported
- 2,521 rides completed

In 2024, we provided safe and reliable transportation to **198** children. To meet rising demand, we hired a Transportation Manager and recruited more drivers to expand access in 2025.

Emilio Snack Bags

Nutritious, hospital-approved snack bags for children fasting before chemotherapy—ensuring no child fights cancer on an empty stomach.

2024 Impact:

 2,600 snack bags distributed at Rady Children's Hospital & Children's Hospital in Orange County



Creating for Hope

We offer one-on-one and group knitting and crocheting sessions for parents, guardians, and children at the hospital, offering a supportive therapeutic outlet. These sessions help build community, offer peer support, and decrease isolation, all while supporting mental health.

2024 Impact:

- 45 one-on-one & group sessions
- Started classes in the Chronic Pain Management Unit

After reinstating in-person sessions, we saw firsthand how creativity eases emotional distress.

End of Life

There are no words to capture the heartache of a family facing the loss of a child. We provide financial assistance, emotional support, and protection from predatory practices when planning a funeral to honor their loved one—ensuring no family grieves alone.

2024 Impact:

• 23 families received funeral stipends & meal cards

We covered **100% of requests** referred by Rady Children's Hospital. As the need grows, we are committed to increasing financial support for grieving families.

Healing Through Nature

In 2025, ENF is launching Healing Through Nature, in partnership with the San Diego River Park Foundation. This program will offer guided outdoor excursions, wellness kits, and nature sessions to help families heal.

We offer outdoor activities for families with children in recent cancer remission, where the healing power of nature helps to boost emotional and physical strength. This experience fosters a supportive community, allowing families to connect, share their journey, and heal from the trauma of a cancer diagnosis.

Together, these six programs encompass ENF's Continuum of Care, ensuring families receive the emotional, financial, and logistical support they need. With your help, we will grow these programs in 2025—bringing hope, healing, and life-saving care to more families than ever before.

Irene, Alivia's Mom

At just 6 years old, Alivia's life was turned upside down when a routine doctor's visit revealed a life-threatening tumor. With no time to waste, her family left everything behind in Oakland to seek treatment, terrified for their little girl's future.

Thanks to the Emilio Nares Foundation, they were able to concentrate on her battle for life, with transportation, resources, and unwavering support, ensuring they didn't have to face their worst nightmare alone.

Iker was just 6 years old when his life was shattered by an acute lymphoblastic leukemia diagnosis. Now 11, he continues to endure the long, grueling trips from Imperial Valley to San Diego for treatment—twice a week, every week.

Through it all, the Emilio Nares Foundation has been their lifeline, providing transportation and the vital snack bags that offer Iker some comfort during his chemotherapy. ENF ensures that families like Iker's never have to face the fight against cancer alone.

Volunteer Impact: A Heartfelt Contribution to Families

Our volunteers are the heart of ENF, last year alone they dedicated over 200 hours of service to ease the burden on families facing childhood illness. Their compassion and commitment ensured that families had one less worry during their unimaginable journey.

Volunteer Contributions:

Snack Bags Program: Volunteers assembled and delivered 2,600 snack bags, providing vital nourishment to children undergoing treatment.

Toy Wrapping: Volunteers wrapped more than 550 toys, bringing joy and light to families during the holiday season.

Weekly Lunches: Volunteers delivered 705 meals, offering comfort and sustenance to families navigating the hardships of childhood cancer.

Thanksgiving Meals: 440 Thanksgiving meals were delivered by volunteers, providing a moment of peace and togetherness during the holiday season.

Our goal is to increase the number of participants and sessions to provide more opportunities for families to fall in love with life, again.

We are also committed to strengthening our End of Life Program to provide more comprehensive resources, ensuring every family facing heartbreak has the support they deserve.
